










### **Trump Vs. Biden Week Before Republican Convention**

#### MENTIONS OVER TIME



# Overall Insights

- During the week of the Republican Convention President Trump saw an increase in <u>engagement and potential reach</u>, but a decrease in mentions.
- Trump's sentiment saw an <u>increase in both positive and negative sentiment</u> during the week of the convention. Overall, Trump did not see any change in the public's opinion of him
- Biden's most positive spike in sentiment came after <u>lvanka Trump's speech.</u>
- The Republican Convention enabled President Trump to <u>take back the</u> <u>advantage</u> on social media, especially regarding volume, but did not change people's feelings about him
