






Increase in negativity due to the actions that the state of New York had taken when it came to the money put into marijuana.















On April 20th there was a spike in mentions and negative sentiment with many upset about a disproportionate number of people of color arrested for cannabis possession.








Areas of high conversation equate to more intense colors.






OVERALL INSIGHTS

- The data shows mixed results regarding whether or not people support the legalization of marijuana.
- Globally, the data supports that the majority of conversation surrounding marijuana is from the United States.
- People are concerned with how COVID-19 is impacting the cannabis industry.
- Marijuana dispensaries are considered essential businesses during the pandemic, which may influence lawmakers in the future to be more open to legalization.
- Some of the data suggests that in the future we may see a decrease of smoking and an increase in other consumption methods due to COVID-19 health risks.
- Much of negative sentiment is due to a disproportionate number of people of color arrested for cannabis possession.
